Property Description

We have a renovated brick building with PV panels, hempcrete walls, hemp batt insulation and sheepswool, with lime hemp plasters & natural clay paints.

We also built the new Straw Lodge. A straw bale building, sat on car tyre foundations, with external lime render and internal clay render.

Why did you make these changes?

We have a focus at Fordhall to limit our environmental impact where possible and to conserve energy in our activities. This means choosing materials with low embodied carbon, materials that can act as a carbon sink, those that limit our fossil fuel use, and also creating buildings which are healthy and happy places for us to work and enjoy.

What were the approximate costs?

The renovation of the Old Dairy was £450,000 and the build cost of the Straw Lodge was £520,000

What have been the approximate energy savings?

Not known, as neither building was in use prior to construction or renovation.

We would like to install ASHP, solar thermal and more PV panels, but funds have hindered their integration. However, as funds become available, we will be investing in more renewable technology onsite.
