### Property Description

Detached house, originally built in 1912 as a Sunday school. Solid wall, slate roof, suspended floor and vaulted ceilings.

## What changes have you made to your home / what green features did your home come with?

We have installed a 9kW solar photovoltaic (PV) panel array with battery storage, heritage style uPVC doors and windows, sustainable insulation, smart room-based heating controls, low energy smart lighting and an electric car charging point.

### Why did you make these changes / choose a home with these features?

We wanted to lower our dependency on grid-based electricity and work towards removing our dependency on gas. This in aid of reducing our environmental impact.

### What were the approximate costs of each of the changes you made?

The solar PV array and battery were roughly £18,000 whilst the uPVC windows and doors were £28,000 and the smart heating controls came to £900. The insulation has cost about £300 so far, but there is a lot more left to do.

### What have been the approximate energy savings?

Heating energy usage has dropped roughly 40%. During the summer months we are a net producer of electricity.

## What have been the benefits to you/your home?

Our home is more comfortable and warmer.

### Who undertook the work?

Solar measures were installed by Octopus Energy whilst we enlisted contractors for the uPVCs and electric car charging point. We carried other works ourselves.

### Would you recommend them?

Octopus Energy were excellent, we would highly recommend them.

## What else would you like to do?

Further insulation, air source heat pump and possibly a solar heating hybrid setup.
