In 2011, we had 10 solar photovoltaic (PV) panels fitted on our roof. April of this year, we fitted a 4.6kW air source heat pump (ASHP).

Why did you make these changes / choose a home with these features?

We want to do our part in tackling climate change.

What were the approximate costs of each of the changes you made?

The ASHP cost us approximately £2,500 as we were awarded £7,500 on top of this from a government grant. The solar PV panels were roughly £10,000 in total whilst the electric car charger cost £800.

What have been the approximate energy savings?

Energy savings are not fully clear yet as the ASHP was recently installed.
