What changes have you made to your home / what green features did your home come with?

When we moved into this property in August 2020, we installed an air source heat pump (ASHP) and solar photovoltaic (PV) panels alongside new double-glazed windows and 300mm insulation in the loft. We recently bought an electric car, soon to be having a home charger installed.

Why did you make these changes / choose a home with these features?

To make our home warmer and more energy efficient.

What were the approximate costs of each of the changes you made?

Approximately it cost us £22,000 in total with £9,500 spent on the ASHP, £5,000 on the solar PV panels and £7,500 on the new double-glazed windows.

What have been the approximate energy savings?

As we started our retrofit journey as soon as we moved into our home, we have no basis to calculate energy savings.
