What changes have you made to your home / what green features did your home come with?

The changes we have made are as follows; cavity wall insulation, solar photovoltaic (PV) panels, solar hot water, upgraded double glazing, panels behind radiators, wood burner, electric vehicle (EV) charge point and energy efficient appliances.

Why did you make these changes / choose a home with these features?

We wanted to greatly reduce our carbon footprint in aid of the environment.

What were the approximate costs of each of the changes you made?

Please note that these figures are from 16 plus years ago; £900 approximately for the cavity wall insulation, £1,200 for the glazing whilst the solar PV panels and solar hot water were roughly £9,000 and £1,800 respectively.

What have been the approximate energy savings?

From having an EV and solar powered heating, our carbon emissions have significantly dropped.



What have been the benefits to you/your home?

Our home feels much warmer and because of the feed-in tariff, our electricity is much cheaper.

Who undertook the work?
